Help with child care costs for working families

You may be able to get help paying for child care while you work!

Apply now at your local DHS office.

You may qualify for ERDC if...

- Your family meets income requirements
- You have a child in your care
- You are working, or working and attending school
- You are self-employed
- You need help paying for child care costs

Things have changed!

- There are higher income limits for families
- You can receive a lower copay when using a high-quality Spark-rated provider
- Child care is approved for 12 months with stable copays
- The ERDC program can now help to pay for child care registration fees
