United Way of Lane County and Banyan Consulting are offering a **six-session workshop series for nonprofit leaders to explore equity** at the personal, interpersonal, and organizational levels.

The series will help leaders hone their skills during a time of culture change while building relationships with peers in interactive sessions co-created by the facilitator and participants.

The series is open to eight Lane County organizations, with a sliding scale fee of \$250-\$750 to offset some cost of the series.

Expectations of participating organizations:

- Executive Director or similar position will participate
- Board Chair or active board leader will participate
- Both team members can attend the orientation (March 16, 9-10:30 a.m.) and all sessions (March 30; April 13, 27; May 11, 25; June 8; and a reunion in September)
- Both team members commit approximately 1hr/week of work between sessions
- Participants commit to respecting confidentiality in the learning process
- Participants complete an initial survey to inform and co-design series content
